Principle Vision

The Sustainable Leather Foundation's approach allows consumers to recognise and understand material Product Life-cycle Management for better informed purchasing decisions when buying leather products. This is possible by assessing and certifying leather manufacturers and associated leather value chain organisations for their performance and compliance against the Sustainable Leather Foundation Audit Standard.

Working with a joined-up approach the Audit Standard is accompanied by a robust set of Standards and Benchmarks, and Explanatory Notes and Templates, that support facilities in understanding what information is required and how it should be presented, monitored and evaluated. In addition, external resources of useful information are also referenced where value can be added.
